MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION

LOCATION AND DESIGN APPROVALS RECEIVED

On February 29, 2012, the Federal Highway Administration granted Location Approval and on June 30, 2012, the Maryland State Highway Administrator granted Design Approval for the MD 175 project from west of MD 295 (Baltimore-Washington Parkway) to MD 170 (Telegraph Road) in Anne Arundel County.

Having received "Location and Design Approval" Final Design has been programmed and engineering plans are underway for the MD 175 Interchange with MD 295 (Phase I). Final design for other portions of the corridor can be completed and engineering plans can be prepared once the project receives additional funding.

Citizen comments received at and after the June 26, 2008 Location/Design Public Hearing were evaluated, made part of the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and considered as part of the decision on the selected alternative. The Public Hearing transcript was previously available for public inspection and review, and it and the FONSI can be found on SHA's website at the address noted below.
