I-695 from MD 41 to MD 147 *Informational Meeting*



The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) has completed design of a project to widen I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) from MD 41 (Perring Parkway) to MD 147 (Harford Road) in Baltimore County. The construction of this project will start in late summer or early fall of 2014 and will take approximately three years to complete, weather permitting. SHA will construct new lanes that serve as continuous auxiliary lanes between the entrance and exit ramps of MD 41 and MD 147. These lanes will provide a safer merge area for vehicles entering and exiting the highway. Crews will also replace the Old Harford Road bridge over I-695 with a wider one that will include Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) - compliant sidewalks and bicycle-compatible shoulders. To improve traffic flow through this section of I-695, the ramp from inner loop I-695 to northbound MD 147 will be removed. The ramp from inner loop I-695 to southbound MD 147 will be widened and a new traffic signal will be installed at the intersection of this ramp with MD 147. After construction is completed, motorists traveling from the I-695 inner loop to southbound and northbound MD 147 will use the same ramp and turn right or left at the new traffic signal.

WHAT: The Informational Meeting will acquaint the public with the project and provide an opportunity to inform SHA of any special concerns. Display areas will be set up showing operational and safety improvements and SHA representatives will be available to discuss project issues and answer questions concerning the proposed construction. No formal presentation will be given. Feel free to arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through at your own pace.
