MD 25 over Georges Run Bridge Replacement
Informational Meeting



The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) invites interested persons to attend an Informational Public Meeting regarding the upcoming replacement of the MD 25 (Falls Road) bridge over Georges Run in Baltimore County. The purpose of this project is to replace the bridge which is structurally safe but is near the end of its usable life. This project is part of SHA's bridge system preservation program aimed at providing reliable facilities in a timely manner while saving money on future maintenance spending. The new structure will be one lane in each direction with shoulders on both sides of the road and improved stream flow underneath the bridge. Both lanes of traffic on MD 25 will be detoured during construction, scheduled to begin in summer 2015. SHA anticipates completing the work in fall 2015, weather permitting.

WHAT: The Informational Meeting will acquaint the public with the project and provide an opportunity to inform SHA of any special concerns. Display areas will be set up showing operational and safety improvements and SHA representatives will be available to discuss project issues and answer questions concerning the proposed construction. No formal presentation will be given. Feel free to arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through at your own pace.
