MD 295 from I-895 to North of Daisy Avenue.

PROJECT WILL REDUCE NOISE ALONG SECTION OF MD 295

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) has initiated the design of a project to install noise walls along MD 295 to reduce highway noise for residents of the Riverview and Baltimore Highlands communities in Baltimore County. The project limits extend approximately 1.1 mile(s) from I-895 to north of Daisy Avenue. SHA will construct a series of barriers along MD 295 to reduce noise from the highway, construct drainage systems to allow stormwater to continue downstream, and include landscaping (tree plantings and slope treatments).

For additional information, you are invited to attend a Public Meeting on October 24, 2013.

You may view the displays at your own pace, speak with project representatives, ask questions and provide comments about the proposed design, and discuss any transportation-related concerns about the project area. There will be no formal presentation.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The MD 295 Noise Wall Project was initiated in 2010, when a resident of Riverview asked SHA to conduct a noise analysis. In 2011, a resident of Baltimore Highlands also requested a noise analysis. In 2012, SHA studied the highway noise levels in both communities and determined that Riverview and Baltimore Highlands were eligible for noise walls. SHA will assume responsibility for all associated construction costs.

SHA appreciates the patience and cooperation of the community and apologizes in advance for any inconvenience. SHA reminds motorist to “think orange” when driving through work zones by staying alert and slowing down. Always buckle up, and please drive safely.




REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE
