



# MD 28 / MD 198 Corridor Improvement Study

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) has reinitiated the MD 28/MD 198 Project Corridor Improvement Study (between MD 97 and I-95 in Montgomery County) and is updating project information, including crash data and traffic analyses. An Informational Public Workshop, which is being planned for Spring 2014, will explain the project planning process, project purpose and need, potential environmental impacts, and proposed alternatives. SHA will continue to provide updates as the project moves forward.

## Project Background

From 2001 to 2008, SHA conducted a study to evaluate improvements along the MD 28 (Norbeck Road) and MD 198 (Spencerville Road) corridor between MD 97 (Georgia Avenue) and I-95. During that time, SHA conducted an Alternates Public Workshop (2002), completed a preliminary Draft Environmental Impact Statement (2004), and conducted an Informational Public Workshop (2008). When the State identified the Intercounty Connector (ICC) as its highest transportation priority, the MD 28/MD 198 Corridor Improvement Study was put on hold. Now that the ICC has been constructed and funding has become available under the Transportation Infrastructure Investment Act, the MD 28/MD 198 project will be studied in the context of the ICC.
