## MD 210 Intersection Closure and Detours begin this Fall

The Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) will close the MD 210 (Indian Head Highway) intersection to crossover traffic between Kerby Hill and Livingston Roads beginning this fall between **October 1 and November 30** and continuing through the life of the project. Once complete, the project will replace the existing intersection of MD 210 at Kerby Hill Road/Livingston Road with an interchange and access ramps that will improve safety and reduce congestion. The \$82 million project should be complete by **year-end 2021**.

## How will traffic be impacted during construction?

Drivers should plan ahead and add extra commute time once the intersection closure begins (**PLEASE SEE MAP BELOW FOR DETOUR DETAILS**). MDOT SHA will use electronic message boards and roadway signage to direct motorists around the intersection closure.

In addition to the intersection closure, intermittent lane closures on MD 210 are possible weekdays between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. and overnight, Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Additional lane closures and work times may be needed to expedite all phases of work and keep the project on schedule.

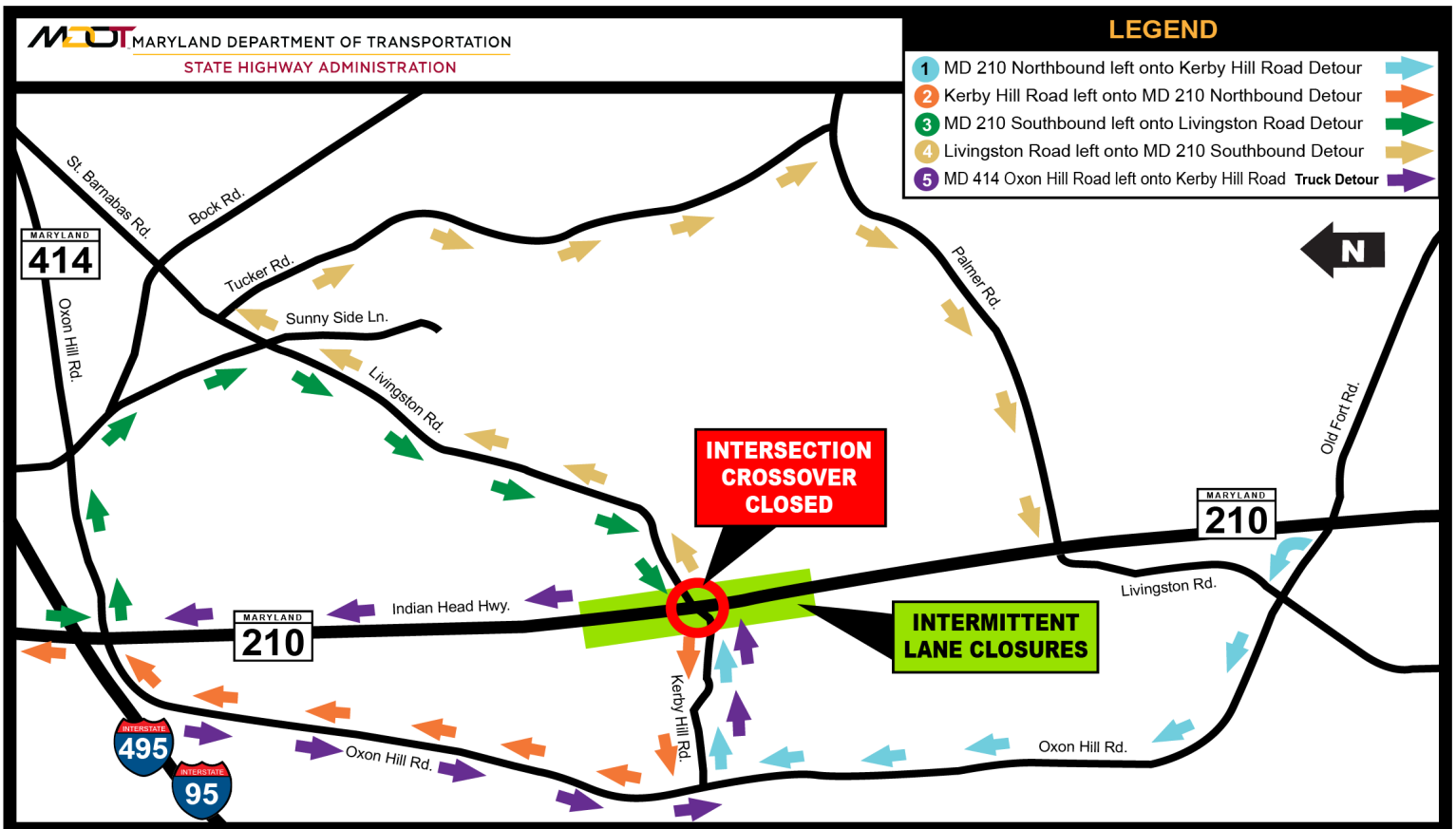

## Detour Route Details

The following approved detour routes should be used for the upcoming closure:

- 1 Northbound MD 210 turning left onto Kerby Hill Road: 2.5 mi.**
  - From MD 210, make a left onto Old Fort Road westbound
  - Go through the traffic light at Livingston Road (Old Fort Road becomes Oxon Hill Road after Livingston Road)
  - Follow Oxon Hill Road to Kerby Hill Road
  - Make a right onto Kerby Hill Road
- 2 Kerby Hill Road turning left onto northbound MD 210: 2.5 mi.**
  - Follow Kerby Hill Road westbound to Oxon Hill Road
  - Make a right onto Oxon Hill Road to access MD 210 northbound / I-495/95 Interchange
- 3 Southbound MD 210 turning left onto Livingston Road: 2.8 mi.**
  - At I-95/495 take eastbound Oxon Hill Road to Livingston Road
  - Make a right onto Livingston Road and follow Livingston Road to access MD 210
- 4 Livingston Road turning left onto southbound MD 210: 4.6 mi.**
  - Follow Livingston Road eastbound to Tucker Road
  - Make a right onto Tucker Road to Palmer Road
  - Make a right onto Palmer Road to access MD 210
- 5 Northbound MD 210 turning left onto Kerby Hill Road: 3.5 mi. (Truck Detour)**
  - Follow northbound MD 210 to MD 414 (Oxon Hill Road)
  - Make a left onto westbound Oxon Hill Road
  - Follow Oxon Hill Road and make a left to access Kerby Hill Road
