



# MD 33 (Talbot Street) from Yacht Club Road to Pea Neck Road Urban Reconstruction Project

### CONCEPT DESIGN WORK BEGINS; PUBLIC MEETING SCHEDULED

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) has begun preliminary design work on an urban reconstruction project that will improve pedestrian safety and accessibility, and upgrade drainage facilities along MD 33 from Yacht Club Road to Pea Neck Road in St. Michaels, Talbot County. The project is intended to upgrade sidewalks and pedestrian ramps that are not compliant with *Americans with Disabilities Act* (ADA) standards and to address drainage conditions along MD 33.

**For additional information, you are invited to attend a Public Meeting on Thursday, July 9, 2015.** The informational meeting will acquaint attendees with the project and give them an opportunity to inform SHA of their project-related concerns. Maps and other displays will provide an overview of the proposed work, and SHA representatives will be available to discuss project-related issues and answer questions. Attendees may arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through the display area at their own pace. **A brief presentation will begin at 6:15 pm.** (See back of flier for meeting details.)

### TASK FORCE PLANNED

Residents and representatives will be able to volunteer as members of a Community Task Force that will work with SHA to ensure that the project concept is consistent with the needs and character of the St. Michaels community. The MD 33 Community Task Force will represent a balanced cross-section of the impacted community, including elected officials, members of community associations, local residents, and business owners/operators, who will discuss goals, concerns, and community preferences for the project. SHA anticipates that the MD 33 Task Force will meet approximately five times over the course of the design process. During the public meeting, SHA representatives will explain the purpose and functions of a task force.


### PROJECT HISTORY

In 2001, SHA worked with a Community Task Force to develop concept plans for comprehensive improvements to MD 33 through the Town of St. Michaels. Due to funding constraints, the project was placed on hold in 2002 before work on the final design could begin. The project received funding for final design in fall 2014, and the design process has been reinitiated. SHA is currently performing topographic surveys of the area and will use that information to develop final design plans as the project moves forward.
