



Stoney Creek Bridge Repair Project

Shuttle Bus Service

July 8 - August 12

Shuttle Bus Service:

- Two shuttle buses will run continuously from 5 a.m. through 9 p.m. every day. A bus should arrive every 30-45 minutes but exact times may vary depending on time of day.
- Buses will be marked “Hubers” and have directional (northbound or southbound) placards displayed in a window.
- Northbound buses will depart Ft. Smallwood Rd./Riviera Plaza at 5 a.m. with stops at Energy Parkway/Ft. Smallwood Rd. and Ft. Smallwood Rd./Stoney Creek Democratic Club.
- Southbound buses will depart Ft. Smallwood Rd./Stoney Creek Democratic Club at 5 a.m. with stops at Energy Parkway/Ft. Smallwood Rd. and Ft. Smallwood Rd./Riviera Plaza.
- Shuttle stops are marked with orange/black “Stoney Creek Bus Stop” signs.

MTA Route 64 Bus Service:

- Route 64 buses will NOT service Riviera Beach during the bridge closure.
- A temporary stop now exists for Route 64 at the Stoney Creek Democratic Club on Ft. Smallwood Rd. north of the bridge.
- Regular Route 64 schedules apply; substitute the Democratic Club stop for the Riviera Beach stop.

The MD 173 (Ft. Smallwood Rd.) drawbridge over Stoney Creek will be CLOSED for repairs July 8 through August 12. For project information contact:
