



## US 220 Tier One Planning Study

MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE  
WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
WILL CONDUCT PUBLIC MEETINGS



The Maryland State Highway Administration, West Virginia Division of Highways, and Federal Highway Administration are evaluating potential transportation corridors to improve north-south mobility, safety, and economic development in the US 220 corridor between I-68 in Cumberland, MD and Corridor H in Grant County, WV.

West Virginia and Maryland will each hold a public meeting to present the results of the engineering and environmental analysis completed during Tier One studies, and to provide an opportunity for the public to offer spoken or written comments before a preferred corridor is selected. In the future, the preferred corridor will provide the basis for a more detailed Tier Two analysis of a specific transportation alternative.
