INFORMATIONAL PUBLIC MEETING SCHEDULED

The Maryland Department of Transportation's Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) is continuing design on an urban reconstruction project on MD 140 (Main Street) from East North Avenue to Timbermill Run in Emmitsburg, Maryland.

For additional information regarding this project, you are invited to attend a public meeting on Wednesday, March 30, 2016 at the Emmitsburg Town Office from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. This informational meeting will acquaint the public with the project and provide attendees an opportunity to inform SHA of their project-related concerns. Display areas will depict the proposed improvements, and SHA representatives will be available to discuss project issues and answer questions. **A formal presentation will begin at 7:30 p.m.**

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Town of Emmitsburg was established in the 1780s and is a historic district. MD 140 (Main Street) runs through Historic Emmitsburg and serves residents, businesses and tourists, carrying more than 10,300 vehicles daily. The existing sidewalk has steep cross slopes, unexpected obstacles, drop-offs, and narrow pathways that are noncompliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. The project is upgrading the pedestrian facilities and proposing to revitalize the Town's square, which is located at the intersection of Seton Avenue (US 15 BU) and Main Street (MD 140).


PROJECT SCOPE AND SCHEDULE

As part of the project along MD140, SHA will complete the following:

- Construct or reconstruct the sidewalks and ramps for compliance with ADA requirements
- Construct/reconstruct curb and gutter

At the intersection of MD 140 and US 15 BU (Seton Ave), SHA will complete the following:

- Upgrade existing sidewalks
- Relocate existing sidewalk ramps
- Reconstruct parking bays
- Reconstruct existing curb and gutter
- Reconstruct traffic signal
- Relocate crosswalks
- Improve drainage
- Resurface the intersection
- Provide landscaping and streetscape amenities



Construction is anticipated to begin in Spring 2017.
