

Cultural Resources

- The preservation of cultural resources is an important consideration for all highway projects
- The National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and Section 4(f) of the US Dept. of Transportation Act of 1966 are the principal laws which guide the preservation process
- The Monocacy National Battlefield is a National Historic Landmark, is listed in the National Register of Historic Places, and contains a number of contributing/eligible resources:
 - The Best Farm - a farmstead and Civil War battlefield
 - The Frederick Junction - one of the first triangular railway junctions
 - The Monocacy River Truss Bridge - individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places
 - The 14th New Jersey Monument - a Civil War Memorial
- In addition, the Monocacy National Battlefield presents a high potential for archeological resources
