The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA), in coordination with Montgomery County, invites interested persons to attend an Alternatives Public Workshop for the MD 97/Georgia Avenue (Montgomery Hills) Project Planning Study. The study limits extend from Forest Glen Road to 16th Street in Montgomery County. The purpose of the project is to establish a balanced approach to transportation within the MD 97 corridor that addresses existing vehicular, pedestrian, and bicyclist mobility and safety, while accommodating proposed transit enhancements and establishing a sense of place within the corridor.

WHAT: The Alternatives Public Workshop will acquaint attendees with the project alternatives and the progress of the study to date. Displays will provide an explanation of the purpose and need for the project, alternatives being considered, potential environmental impacts, and related projects. Project representatives will be available to discuss project issues, answer questions, and record comments. **No formal presentation will be given.** Attendees may arrive at any time between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. and walk through at their own pace.
