The purpose of this Notice is to advise Contractors and Engineering Consultant firms that the State Highway Administration (SHA) will be holding an INFORMATIONAL MEETING on the CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK (CMAR) project delivery method.

Description:

CMAR is a project delivery method where a construction manager is procured utilizing the Competitive Sealed Proposal process to provide a range of preconstruction services to SHA during the design phase of a project. These services may include, but are not limited to, constructability analysis, value engineering, scheduling, site assessments, and cost estimating. The Construction Manager would act as a general contractor during the construction phase upon agreement with SHA to deliver the project at an agreed upon price.

The SHA is looking to pilot the CMAR project delivery process in 2013. An informational meeting will be held with the contracting and consultant engineering industries to present the SHA's proposed approach to CMAR and to solicit industry input and feedback prior to issuing any Request for Proposals.
