What to Expect During Construction

Changing Traffic Patterns

The construction of the I-695 / Frederick Road (MD 144) Improvements will be accomplished by shifting traffic lanes along I-695 and Frederick Road to create work zones for workers and equipment.

On the Frederick Road bridge, traffic initially will be moved to the south side of the existing bridge while the north side is demolished and reconstructed. Lanes will be narrowed; however, the single through lanes in each direction and the left turn lane will be maintained. Following construction of the north side, traffic will be moved to the new portion of the bridge while the existing south side is demolished and reconstructed.

Most ramps will have periodic nighttime and / or weekend closures. Advanced warning and alternate routes will be provided.



Two ramps will be closed for multiple week periods:

- ➔ Ramp from the Outer Loop of I-695 to Frederick Road (Ramp 8)
 - Traffic will be detoured to the Wilkens Avenue (MD 372) Interchange
 - Closure is required during a portion of Construction Stage 2
- ➔ Ramp from Frederick Road to the Outer Loop of I-695 (Ramp 6)
 - Traffic will be detoured to the Edmondson Avenue Interchange
 - Closure is required during a portion of Construction Stage 3
