### Project Design Updated; Public Meeting Scheduled

The Maryland Department of Transportation's State Highway Administration (SHA) is continuing design on the MD 26 Safety and Resurfacing Project in Libertytown, located in Frederick County. The project extends along MD 26 for just over a mile from West South Street to MD 31. The project will help reduce speed and improve pedestrian safety. Construction is scheduled to begin next year.

**For additional information, you are invited to attend a public workshop on Wednesday, July 13, 2016.** The informational meeting will update the public about the project's status and engineering design and provide attendees an opportunity to discuss project details. Maps and displays will provide an overview of the proposed improvements and MDOT/SHA representatives will be available to answer project-related questions. **There will be no formal presentation.** You may arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace. ### Project Purpose and Scope


The purpose of this project is to introduce traffic calming elements and improve pedestrian safety through Libertytown through the MDOT/SHA system preservation program. Proposed improvements include:

- Raised medians on either end of Libertytown for traffic calming
- Resurfacing and new pavement markings
- Pedestrian crossing improvements at the intersection of MD 26 and MD 75
- Pedestrian crossing at Libertytown Park
