PROJECT UPDATE

The I-70 Phase 2D project is in its 15th month of design and 10th month of construction.

Construction activities completed last month included installation of drainage pipe for I-70 eastbound Exit 55 South Street on/off ramps.

Construction activities scheduled for this month include drilling foundation beams for the pier, installing drainage pipe along I-70 eastbound, and installation of erosion & sediment controls along I-70.

Construction activities for next month include bridge pier support wall construction and installing drainage pipe along I-70 eastbound/westbound.

For everyone's safety, please drive carefully, stay alert and reduce speed when traveling within the project work zone.
