1. Crews have installed beams across the remaining two spans of the new MD 140 bridge.
2. Crews have poured the concrete curbs and bridge deck (driving surface) on these remaining spans. The concrete is curing.

Upcoming Work:

1. Crews will complete paving in the project area.
2. Crews will install guardrail.
3. Crews will complete landscaping work in the project area.
