

The MD 223 Open House is being conducted for major stakeholders: residents, property-owners, businesses, churches, schools, government agencies, and others within the project area who may be most affected by the preliminary alternatives for the MD 223 Project Planning Study. **You have been identified as a major stakeholder and are being invited to attend the Open House.**

Project Description

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA), in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is conducting a Project Planning Study on MD 223 from Steed Road to MD 5 (Branch Avenue) in Prince George's County.

The main purpose of the project is to address the need for safety improvements and additional capacity to accommodate existing and future traffic volumes on MD 223. The project would improve the following:

- traffic flow
- pedestrian and bicyclist safety
- access to homes, schools, businesses, and places of worship
- east-west connections to major roadways within the region

Purpose of the Open House

The Open House will provide information about the proposed location and general design of the project's preliminary alternatives, including the associated social, economic, cultural, and environmental impacts, and will offer major stakeholders the opportunity to present their opinions about the project. Display areas and maps will explain the alternatives being developed and their potential environmental impacts. The project team hopes to gain a better understanding of community-related needs and potential impacts associated with the proposed improvements and will be available to discuss project issues, answer questions, and record comments. Project handouts and comment cards will be available. No formal presentation will be given.
