

FOR THE

**US 1/MD 201 CORRIDOR STUDY
FROM MD 198 TO I-95/I-495 (THE CAPITAL BELTWAY)
IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY**



This study will develop and evaluate possible improvements to the US 1/MD 201 Corridor from MD 198 to I-95/I-495 (The Capital Beltway) in Prince George's County. The project planning phase includes agency and public involvement, the review of all reasonable alternatives, including the No-Build Alternative, and an evaluation of social, economic and natural environmental impacts. It concludes with the receipt of location and design approvals if a build alternative is selected.

As a part of the public involvement activities, and consistent with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, comments are invited regarding historic properties in the project area, including standing structures and archeological resources.

Citizen involvement in the planning process is encouraged.
